PAYMENT SEATS:

The GM/OBC/Minorities candidates seeking admission under Payment Category shall pay the following fees (Shown in Column 3) in addition to the regular fees. Since fees paid under payment seats is not reimbursable from the Govt. SC/ST/Cat-I candidates whose parents annual income is less than 2.5 Lakhs are required to pay (Shown in Column 4) in addition to other fees.

ELIGIBILITY FEES:

Candidates outside Karnataka shall pay the following *Eligibility fees* in addition to the regular fees. The candidates studied abroad shall obtain Eligibility Certificate from Bangalore University before taking admission.

FEE PRESCRIBED FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS & NRIs:

The Foreign Nationals and NRIs shall pay US \$2,750 per annum in addition to eligibility fees.

The prescribed fees shall be paid online payment and submit the same in the authorized admission counters.

The eligible students shall pay prescribed examination fees prior to the semester examination within the stipulated date for payment of fees as notified by the Registrar (Evaluation). Examination Branch. The SC/ST candidates within Karnataka and whose parents annual income is less than 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) per annum shall pay only the OMR sheet fee, since the prescribed examination, application, marks card, convocation fees, etc., will be reimbursed by the Social Welfare Department.

FEES CONCESSION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR SC/ST CANDIDATES:

The SC/ST candidates within Karnataka and whose parents annual income is less than 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) per annum shall pay Rs.300/- (Rupees Three Hundred Only) for regular seats and Rs. 300/- plus payment fees for payment seats (excluding *reimbursable compulsory fees) subject to submission of the photocopies of the following valid documents/certificates at the time of admission. The other compulsory fees of SC/ST candidates will be reimbursed from the Social Welfare Department (ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಆದೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ ಸಸಇ 83, ಪಕವಿ 2012, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು, ದಿನಾಂಕ: 29/06/2012)

Online acknowledgement (Post-Metric application) 15 digits Registration No. of Social Welfare Department.

1. Caste Certificate issued in Karnataka by the Tahsildhar, within last five years.
2. Parents Income Certificate issued in Karnataka by the Tahsildhar on or after 01/04/2012 (which is valid for five years)
3. Last month salary certificates of parents who are working in any Government/Semi-Government/Private sector.
4. SSLC / CBSE / ISCE Marks Card (candidates studied in Karnataka only).
5. Aadhaar Card.
6. Previous year Marks Card.
7. Bank Pass book (Bank account should be in the name of the Candidate).

The fees reimbursement is not applicable to SC/ST students from other States. Fees reimbursement is also not applicable to the candidates who have already pursued the Undergraduate course/5 year Integrated course (UG/5 year Integrated course discontinued is also taken into account). Such candidates shall pay the prescribed fees.

Cat-I, 2A, 3A & 3B and other students shall pay the prescribed Regular and Examination fees.

As per ಸರ್ಕಾರದ ಆದೇಶ ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ ಹಿಂಪಕ 589 ಬಿಎಂಎಸ್, ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು ದಿನಾಂಕ: 05/10/2013 Cat-I candidates whose Parents' annual income is less than or equal to Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) and candidates irrespective of Case / Community / Religion, (2A, 3A, 3B and others) who have studied for a period of 7 (Seven) academic years (commencing from 1st std. upto the qualifying examination either continuously or in broken period) and whose parents' Annual income is less than or equal to Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) are eligible to claim the reimbursement of Tuition, Laboratory, Library, Sports and Examination fees. Eligible students shall apply for the same as and when it is notified by the Backward Classes Welfare Department (BCWD). The BCWD will reimburse the above fees or the fee reimbursable by the BCWD whichever is less, only to such student who are eligible as per their norms. (Please refer www.karepass.ogg.gov.in;) received by the University from the Backward Classes Welfare Department (BCWD) will be disbursed to the students.

The candidates belonging to minorities (i.e., Anglo-Indians, Buddhists, Christians, Jains, Muslims, Parsis, Sikhs, etc.,) shall pay the prescribed Regular and Examination fees.

The Principal shall ascertain the receipt of fees reimbursement from the Social Welfare Department with the Officer of the Director, Student Welfare, BUB or from the website of Social Welfare Department under scholarship application status. In case of non-receipt of Fees reimbursement for what-so-ever reasons mentioned therein by the Social Welfare Department, such students shall be directed to pay the prescribed Regular fees and Odd & Even semester Examination fees before appearing for the Even semester Examination.
