

With effect from the year 2023-24, the Government of India in consultation with the Department of Education and the Department of Social Welfare, has directed that the students belonging to SC/ST category whose annual income of the family is less than Rs.2.5 Lakhs and are eligible for the post-metric scholarship, will be provided admission (excluding non reimbursable fee/deposit amount if any) without having to pay any compulsory fees at the time of admission subject to submission of Freeship card.

The SC/ST applicants who wish to claim fee concession/availing admission without Prepayment of compulsory fees may be directed to submit the 'Scholarship sanctioned status of the previous year (2024-25)/ Freeship card of previous Academic year which can be downloaded from the student's login in the SSP Portal. Further, they may also be directed to submit a copy of the valid Income and Caste Certificate issued by the Tahsildar along with Scholarship sanctioned status.

However, the students who are seeking admission without pre-payment of compulsory fee to the following courses shall pay the fees which are not entitled for reimbursement from the Social Welfare Department i.e., Cultural activity (Rs.200/-), Student activity fee (Rs.100/-), User Fee (Rs.200/-) for regular seats plus payment fee for self finance / payment seat subject producing of freeship card .

The Principal, University Law college, Jnana Bharathi , Bengaluru, shall direct the SC/ST students (who have taken admission without pre-payment of compulsory fee of the respective course) to pay the Balance of course fee after received from the scholarship amount Social Welfare Department, Government of Karnataka, i.e., fees due to be paid at the time of admission, prior to payment of II/ IV/VI/VIII/ X semester examination fee. In case of non-receipt of course Fees reimbursement for what so-ever reasons (non-submission/incomplete submission of scholarship application, submission of application after due date, etc.) mentioned therein / short payment of fee reimbursement by the Social Welfare Department, such students shall also be directed to pay the balance of course fees in full (which was due to be paid at the time of admission), prior to payment of II/IV/VI/VIII/X semester examination fee.

The original marks cards submitted by the student at the time of admission and /or other documents (Examination marks card, Degree Certificate/PDC, TC etc.,) shall not be issued until the students clear all the dues to the University Law college, Jnana Bharathi, Bengaluru.

Students belonging to SC/ST category of other State and SC/ST students of Karnataka whose family annual income is above Rs.2.50 Lakhs shall pay full fees.

<u>Mode of Payment</u>: (1) Selected students shall pay the above fees through online on Bangalore University Website: <u>https://bangaloreuniversity.karnataka.gov.in</u> and submit the copy of the receipt to the concerned University Law college.

REFUND AND FORFEITURE OF FEES

- (1) Candidate for any reason may cancel his/her seat by submitting the following documents;
- i) Original Provisional Admission Card
- ii) Original Fee Receipt
- iii) Application for cancellation of seat and refund of fee paid with clear & complete correspondence address with Bank details

And

(2) Refund shall be considered as per clause 5 of the UGC Fee Refund Policy 2024-25 vide D.O. No.F.2-71/2022 (CPP-II) (C-114546) dated: 12th June 2024 clause 5 the following tier system for the refund of fees* remitted by the student shall be followed:

SI. No.	Percentage of Refund of fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the University
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission.
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission.
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission.
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission.
5	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission.

The Office of the Registrar (Evaluation) shall notify the prescribed examination & convocation fee as per this notification.

The Principal of University Law College Bangalore University Bangalore shall ensure that the students whose admissions are not approved by the University/ having shortage of attendance and those students who do not fulfill the requirements shall not be allowed to appear for the examination. Further, the student shall be admitted to III/V/VII/IX Semester only as per regulation of the course.
